<b>W H E N</b>	<p><u>Request ballot</u> asap (before 2/27) and bring to <u>Durham Board of Election</u> or mail ASAP (must ARRIVE by March 5)</p>	<p><b>February 15- March 2</b> <u>Find One Stop Early Voting days &amp; times</u></p>	<p><b>Tuesday, March 5</b> enter time between 6:30 am – 7:00 pm (polls close at 7:30 pm)</p>
<b>W H E R E</b>	<p>enter where you will drop off the ballot</p> <p>bring to <u>Durham Board of Election</u> or mail with postmark</p>	<p>enter your choice of early voting site</p> <p><u>Find One Stop Early Voting locations</u></p>	<p>You must vote at your assigned precinct!</p> <p><u>Find your polling place</u></p>

## VOTING CHECKLIST & TIPS

- Download your sample ballot from [ncsbe.gov voter lookup](https://ncsbe.gov/voter-lookup)
- Request mail-in absentee ballot ASAP - by **February 27th** if voting by mail
- Your mail in ballot now must be RECEIVED by March 5 – there is no longer a grace period and there are no exceptions. Mail your ballot ASAP if you are voting absentee
- Check your registration status at [NCSBE.gov](https://ncsbe.gov). If not registered to vote, register in person or online by **February 9th** -OR- plan to register & vote at One-Stop Early Voting
- Share your Voting Plan on social media to challenge others to do the same and tag @kidsvotingdurham
- Research the candidates and issues that are important to you using reliable sources like the [KVD Election Guide](#)
- Talk to your family & others, including those with views or life experiences different than yours, about candidates and issues
- Cast your vote & celebrate!
