Kids Voting Durham (KVD) is offering youth age 14-24 virtual internship opportunities this summer. KVD is looking for volunteers who want to deepen or develop their outreach, writing, technical, design or other skills while empowering other youth to be civically engaged. All opportunities are virtual, to be completed by youth with virtual support and direction from Kids Voting staff. Working on the KVD 2021 Election Guide, KVD civic education materials, and other projects, will youth have the opportunity to learn new skills and deepen existing ones while creating materials and resources that are valued by youth ,educators, and leaders in the Durham community. Youth work in a fun, inclusive team environment where youth voice is valued and youth have a genuine decision-making role.

TIME: 10-25 hours/week, June 21 (or earlier)-July 30 (dates are flexible)

BENEFITS

Intern receives:

- Measured skills growth and other evaluations over the course of the internship
- Leadership and facilitation training
- Access to software and tech tools needed to complete projects
- Access to professionals from various fields for mentorship and advice
- Take part in at least 1x/week direct online guidance/mentoring with Kids Voting Program Director as well as on-call coaching and support from Kids Voting adult ally network
- A personalized letter of recommendation upon completion

- Are eligible for service hours
- Can take part in team and skill building sessions with the entire youth team
- Receive name credit on all materials produced and in KVD social media
